Amtrak Employee Suspended for Leaving Work Without Authorization Case Number 09-172 April 27, 2010

An anonymous source alleged that a Back Bay Station employee left the station on numerous occasions to go to a local gym without the knowledge or authorization of management while on company time. A comparison of employee payroll records and gym attendance records was conducted and it was determined that the employee left work while on duty on 12 separate occasions to go to the gym. The employee waived a Formal Investigation and was assessed a twenty-day suspension (held in abeyance) and was required to pay \$298.56 in restitution to Amtrak for time paid but not worked.
